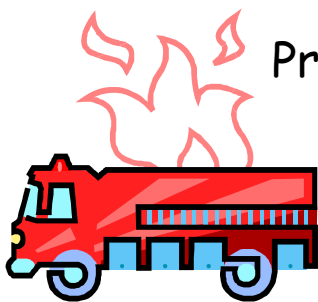

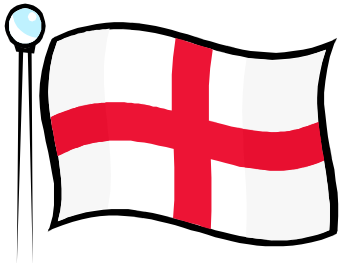
Project Vulcan Saturday 15th October



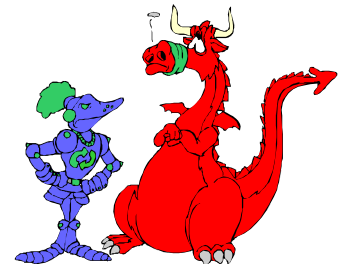
The Emergency Service are putting on an open session to help with Personal Safety, etc on Saturday 15th October at Gilwell Park.
