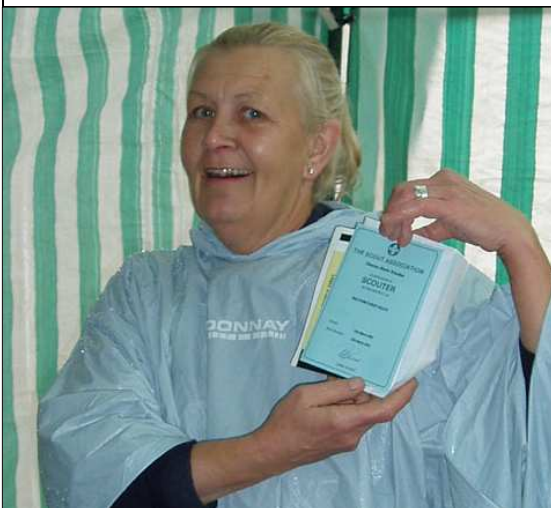
Back home rehearsals were in full swing for our **60th Anniversary Gang Show**, well produced by Brendon, Charlie, and Robert.
